A special meeting, duly convened by the Chairman, was held at the Vicarage at 7 pm to consider a letter from the Postmaster General respecting telegraph facilities to be afforded to Kentmere. On the motion of Mr W. Birkett – seconded by Mr John Gilpin it was unanimously resolved that the Chairman forward the subjoined resolution to the Postmaster General in answer to his letter of June 17.09.

Resolved “that this meeting is of opinion that it would be for the benefit of Kentmere that a telegraph office should be established in the village of Kentmere and hereby undertake to guarantee the Postmaster General against loss to be sustained by reason of the establishment or maintenance of such an office in accordance with the power conferred by the Post Office amendment Act 1895.”
