*The annual assembly of the Parish Meeting was held this evening at the School at 7.30 pm & was well attended. The notice convening the meeting was read, & the minutes of the last meeting were read & signed. Mr John Gilpin proposed & Mr James Gilpin of Pout Howe seconded the re-election of the chairman the Rev. R.J. Pigott. carried unanimously. Precepts in favour of the chairman for the deficit on the telegraph guaranteed to defray the expenses connected with the Parish Meeting was signed. Mr John Gilpin proposed Mr Tom Dixon of Brockstone as one of the overseers Mr Birkett Bland seconded – carried unanimously. Mr Birkett Bland proposed & Mr R. Taylor seconded the appointment of Mr William Birkett as the other overseer – Mr Noble Gregg proposed & Mr Matthew Gould seconded the appointment of Mr John Gilpin – on being put to the vote 8 voted for Mr Birkett & 15 for Mr John Gilpin – Mr John Gilpin was elected. As ????? authority manager of Kentmere School Mr Noble Gregg was proposed by Mr G. Hayton & seconded by Mr John Gilpin – Mr Birkett was proposed by Mr Taylor & seconded by Mr B. Bland. On being put to the vote 15 votes were given for Mr Gregg and 8 for Mr Birkett. Mr Gregg was therefore appointed.. Letter from Chief Constable respecting fees to be paid to the P.O. for the use of the telegraph when the office was closed in case of an outbreak of fire was read – discussed - & not entertained. Proposed by Mr Birkett & seconded by Mr N. Gregg that the chairman have power to favourably reply to any questions addressed to him respecting the granting of a half holiday every Saturday afternoon to the rural postman for Kentmere.*
