At the request of the Kendal Rural War Agricultural Sub Committee a meeting of the Farmers & others was held this evening to see what could be done here in the three directions indicated in the circular note, viz. Garden cultivation – Pig keeping – Growing of potatoes. The farmers had already received papers on the subject to fill in and return - & of the few cottages in the parish in many cases only the wife is left at home. Still the feeling of the meeting was very strongly that, while everyone should be encouraged to grow as many potatoes as possible, the high price of feeding stuffs would prevent cottages keeping pigs. A copy of this decision was forwarded to the R. A. S. the following day.
