The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held this evening at the School at 7.30 pm pursuant to notice. Mr Voss proposed and Mr Bernard Gilpin seconded the re-election of the Rev. R. Jackson Pigott as chairman – and this was carried unanimously. The minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed. Mr Bernard Gilpin proposed and Mr John Gilpin seconded the election of Mr Gerard Hayton and Mr Joseph Bland as overseers, and this was carried unanimously. The chairman called the attention of Mr Hayton who was present to the condition of the High Bridge, and he undertook to examine it, & have it put in order. The chairman to see the Clerk to the R. D. C. as to liability to repair. The chairman read a letter he had received from Colonel Weston dated March 5 "Appeal for male workers", & a copy of reply sent. The matter was fully considered, and the reply forwarded on March 6 was approved. A precept in favour of the chairman was signed. This concluded the business.
