The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held in the School pursuant to notice at 7 pm. There were 10 members present. Mr Edward Wood Bindloss proposed and Mr Jack Bland seconded the election of the Reverend R.J. Pigott - Vicar - as Chairman, which was carried unanimously. The Vicar thanked the meeting for the honour they had again done him & assured them of his best services at all times. The minutes of the last meeting were then read - approved - and signed. Mr Edward Wood Bindloss and Mr Joseph Allen were appointed overseers, & on the motion of the chairman the minor Authority member - whose term of office had expired - was reappointed. The chairman on the motion of Mr James Black, seconded by Mr Jack Bland was desired to write to the Postmaster General, & enquire if a public telephone could be arranged for Kentmere, & if so what conditions & report to a later meeting. If no reply was received to the Chairman's telegram to Mr Nelson regarding the dangerous state of the High Bridge by Saturday morning to report the matter to the clerk of the District Council. A letter also to be sent to the Kendal Bus Co^y enquiring if they could see their way to establishing a bus service from Kentmere to Kendal at least twice a week. This concluded the business.
