The Annual Meeting Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held in the Institute on March 25th at 7.30 p.m. after due notice. Mr J. Black was in the chair. There were six members present.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Arising out of the Minutes Mr Taylor asked if anything had been done in regard to the refuse tip. Mr Black swiftly outlined the position and stated that the tip would soon be ready.

It was proposed by Mr Robinson and seconded by the Revd J. Scholfield that Mr Black be re-elected Chairman. Carried nem. con.

It was proposed by Mr Taylor and seconded by Mr Bland that Mr Black and Mr Salkeld be re-elected Parish Representatives on the Rating and Valuation Committee. Carried nem. con.

It was proposed by Mr Salkeld and seconded by Mr Bland that Mrs Robinson be elected Minor Local Authority Representative on the as the School Managers for the years 1937 – 40. Carried.

It was proposed by Mr Robinson and seconded by Mr Salkeld that as on the occasion of the King's Jubilee a house to house collection be made. The money expended on a tea for the children between the ages of 3 and 16 years. Any surplus money to be spent to provide Coronation Mugs for children younger than school age. Mr Black offered to collect on the east side and Mr Robinson on the west side of the river.
