Annual Meeting postponed from March 27th 1940

Mr Black was in the chair & eight others were present.

Proposed by Mr Gilkes(?) seconded by Mr Stowe that Mr Dirkin be Chairman

Amendment proposed by Rev. J. Tweedfold(?) seconded by Mr Black that Mr Robinson be Chairman.

On the amendment & proposition being put to the meeting Mr Dirkin was elected by 4 votes to 3. Mr Dirkin then took the chair.

The meeting then proceeded to the election of two representatives to the rating and valuation committee.

Proposed by Mr Black sec Mr Williams – Mr Salkeld

Proposed by Vicar seconded Mr Black – Mr Robinson

Messrs Salkeld & Robinson were unanimously elected.

Proposed by the Vicar seconded by Mr Black that Mrs Robinson be reelected Manager of the School for the years 1940 – 43. Carried unanimously.

A letter was read from Mr (?) Clerk of the S.W.R.D.C. notifying the meeting of the death of Mr Joseph Wood inviting the chairman to attend a meeting in Kendal to nominate a successor to Mr Wood on the S.W.R.D.C. From the Chair Mr Dirkin proposed & Mr Black seconded that Mr Robinson's name should be submitted – carried unanimously.

The Vicar raised the question of the bus & Mr Robinson offered to write to the Clerk of the County Council on the matter.
