The minutes of the last meeting were read & confirmed.

Mr A. M. Robinson read a letter from Mr George Dirkin resigning the office of Chairman of the Parish Meeting.

It was proposed by the Rev^d B Scholfield & seconded by Mr George Salkeld & carried unanimously that Arthur Mackenzie Robinson of Greenhead, Kentmere be elected Chairman for the ensuing year.

It was proposed by the Rev^d B. Scholfield seconded by Mr T Gillies & carried unanimously that Mr G Salkeld & Mr A. M. Robinson be reelected representatives of Kentmere on the Assessment Committee of the South Westmorland R.D.C.

The Chairman was requested by the meeting to write to the Clerk to the Westmorland County Council as to

(a) The damaged condition of the parapet of Low Bridge

(b) The bad state of the road leading from Crosshowe to Hallowbank via Green Quarter.

The Chairman was further requested to ascertain the position as to the contract for the removal of household refuse to the dump near Kentmere Hall on the approaching termination of Mr M. Gibson's tenancy.
