The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held in the Kentmere Institute on the above date at 8 pm pursuant to notice.

The minutes of the last meeting were read & confirmed.

The Chairman reported that the matters referred to in the latter part of the minutes just read had been satisfactorily disposed of.

It was proposed by the Rev^d B. Scholfield & seconded by Mr George Salkeld that Mr A. M. Robinson be reelected Chairman for the ensuing year. This was carried unanimously.

It was proposed by Mr Edward Black, seconded by the Rev^d B. Scholfield & carried nem. con. That Mr G. Salkeld & Mr A. M. Robinson be reelected representatives of Kentmere on the Assessment Committee of the South Westmorland R.D.C.

The Chairman reported what happened at a meeting of the South Westmorland R.D.C. attended by Mr G. Dirkin and himself on housing in small outlying villages. It was not proposed to erect cottages in Kentmere. The Chairman further reported correspondence he had had with the Water Engineer of the S. Westmorland R.D.C. as to wells & water supplies in Kentmere.

A suggestion by Mr G. Salkeld that notice should be given of the collection of household rubbish was approved by the meeting.
