Election of Chairman

On the motion of Mr George Dirkin seconded by the Revd B Scholfield Mr A. M. Robinson was unanimously elected chairman for the ensuing year

Election of Representatives on the assessment committee of the SWRDC.

The reelection of Mr George Salkeld & Mr A. M. Robinson was proposed by the Revd B. Scholfield seconded by Mr G. Black & carried unanimously.

Parish Councils Association

The Chairman reported his attendance at a meeting of the above association held in the County Hall, Kendal on the 23rd February 1946.

On the motion of the Revd B. Scholfield seconded by Mr George Dirkin it was resolved that Kentmere Parish Meeting should join the association & be represented by the chairman.

Kentmere Road

The Chairman read the letter he had been instructed to write at the last meeting & the letter of the Road Surveyor in reply date the 24th March last.

The Chairman was directed to write again & point out that nothing had been done & the road was deteriorating rapidly.

Collection of household rubbish

The Chairman read his letter to the Sanitary Inspector & his reply of the 3rd inst. The Chairman was directed to reply & point out that his letter had not yet been (un?)ed & say that tenders should be invited.

Electricity Project

The Chairman read letters he had received in reply to those written by him as directed by the last meeting

He said that after ascertaining the right authority to whom to write he had written to the Electricity Commissioners Savoy Court Strand London WC2, but so far had no reply. He would write again & also urge the newly elected members of the County Council & SWRDC to action.

Kentmere P O

The Chairman reported that he had heard from the Head Postmaster, Kendal that he would permit the Kentmere P.O. to issue various kinds of licences & do Savings Bank Business, but he did not think there would be enough money order business to justify him in granting leave to do this.
