The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held in the Institute on the above date at 8 pm pursuant to notice.

The minutes of the last meeting were read & confirmed.

It was proposed by the Rev^d B Scholfield & seconded by Mr P B Turner & carried unanimously that Mr A. M. Robinson be reelected Chairman for the ensuing year.

It was proposed by the Rev^d B. Scholfield seconded by Mr P. B. Turner & carried unanimously that Mr G. Salkeld & Mr A. M. Robinson be reelected representatives of Kentmere Parish on the Assessment Committee of the South Westmorland R.D.C.

Parish Councils Association

The Chairman reported his attendance at a meeting of the above Association & that 2 questions (in addition to details as to the Constitution) had been discussed, viz The alteration of Parish Boundaries & the question of Rights of Way. The members of the Parish present at the meeting did not think any action by the meeting was called for at present. The Chairman reported that the Kentmere Parish Meeting had joined the Association & that he had paid a subscription of 10/-

Kentmere Road

The Chairman reported that 2 portions of this road had been reconstructed viz 1 Between 'Scroggs' and 'Barley' Bridges & 2 between Mill Rigg & the Diatomite works. He had frequently pressed for more reconstruction but the answer was that the cost was too great. He had also insisted that pot holes should be patched all along the road & this had been done.

Electricity Project

The Chairman reported further correspondence as to this since the last meeting.

In view of (1) the large guarantees of income demanded by the Co before the extension was undertaken & (2) the approaching nationalisation of the industry, members thought no action by the meeting was desirable

Collection of household rubbish

The Chairman reported that he had urged Mr Arimistead to make a collection of rubbish before leaving Kentmere Hall. The Chairman added that later he communicated with the Sanitary Inspector RDC who stated that he proposed to make the collection in future by means of the RDC truck,
