Parish Councils Association

The Chairman reported that the following subjects had been raised in letters from the above association.

Old Parish Records *The Vicar & the members present did not know of any old parish records that ought to be deposited in the new strong room at the County Hall except perhaps some old rate books.*

Land owned by the Parish or common land

Members present did not know of any common land or land owned by the Parish which ought to be mentioned to the Planning Officer of the County.

Flooding at Pumple Syke

The Chairman reported complaints by the owners of Wray Cottage of difficulty in egress from their home to the road owing to floods, (?) complaint to the County Road Surveyor & an interview with his representatives on the ground. No proposal had yet been made by the Surveyor & members present saw no means of preventing the flooding.

Kentmere Road *The Chairman promised to keep the state of the road from time to time before the Surveyor*
