The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held at the Institute on the above date, pursuant to notice, at 8 p.m.

The Minutes of the last Annual Assembly were read and approved.

It was proposed by Mrs Williams and seconded by Mrs Morton that the present Chairman Mr R. Pighills be re-elected.

Correspondence with the North Western Electricity Board was studied and it was agreed that parishioners, especially farmers, should approach the Board individually in the hope that electricity would be supplied to the Parish in the near future.

The Chairman was instructed by the Meeting to write to the Westmorland County Surveyor (a) to request that the road between Cross How and Brockstones be resurfaced in the near future, (b) that a suitable warning notice to motorists should be erected near the sharp corner adjoining Bridge Stone and (c) that the sign near the Institute "Troutbeck – unfit for motors" should be removed either altogether, or to a point nearer the Nook as motorists had been misled into thinking that the road beyond the notice was unsuitable for cars.
