The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held at the Institute, pursuant to notice, on the above date at 8 p.m.

The Minutes of the last Annual Assembly held on 25th March 1965 were read and approved.

It was proposed by Mr John Williams and seconded by Mrs Williams that Mr Joseph Jackson Hayton be appointed Chairman of the Parish. The present chairman at this stage reminded the meeting that he had for some years past indicated that he would be pleased to hand over the Chairmanship to a younger man with a Kentmere background at some time convenient to the Meeting. It was proposed by Mrs Black and seconded by Mr Andrew Williams that the present Chairman should, if willing, continue in office. On a show of hands since both motions showed the same number in favour of each, the Chairman voting in favour of his continuance in office, with the recommendation that the question be reviewed at the half-yearly Meeting to be held in October, when a larger attendance might result in a more representative decision of the Meeting.

It was proposed by Mrs Williams and seconded by Mrs Black that no action be taken regarding the forthcoming Staveley Fete.

Following a discussion of the Review of Common Lands, rights and privileges, it was decided that a Special Parish Meeting to discuss the subject and form a Committee should be held on the 19th May 1966 at 8 p.m. and that in the meantime the Chairman should secure available information on the subject.
