*The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held at the Institute, pursuant to notice, on the above date at 8 p.m.*

*Present were Couuncillor Mrs S. Walshaw, Mr John Williams, Mr & Mrs Black, Mr & Mrs Bialy, Mr K. Dawson, Mr A Morton, Mr Andrew Williams and the Chairman.*

*The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and approved.*

*It was proposed by Mr Morton and seconded by Mrs Black that the present Chairman, Mr R. Pighills, should continue in office.*

*A discussion on roads, bridges and footpaths was held and the Chairman was asked:-*

- (a) to enquire about the erection of notices indicating footpaths from Green Quarter to Longsleddale and from Gravengate and Low Lane to Kentmere Church.*
- (b) to ask whether the words "unfit for cars" could be added to the signpost near Stile End pointing to Longsleddale.*
- (c) to express the appreciation of the Parish of the work done in the past year by the County Surveyor's department especially as regards snow clearance.*

*The Chairman informed the meeting that Mr Lyons, the lessee of Kentmere Quarries had appealed against the refusal of planning permission to operate the quarries and that a Public Enquiry was likely to be held shortly. In these circumstances, the Chairman suggested that any discussion of the subject was inadvisable and in any case premature.*

*A suggestion by the trustees of the late Mr A.N. Clegg of Poulton-le-Fylde for the erection of a stone seat near the Church was discussed.*

*Mrs Walshaw gave the meeting the latest information on proposals for new schools and redirection of children to middle and secondary schools in the County and also explained proposals under the County Welfare schemes for flatlets for elderly people and for new accommodation for elderly people no longer physically and mentally able to look after themselves.*
