The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held at the Institute, pursuant to notice, on the above date at 7.30 p.m.

Present at the Meeting were the Chairman, Mrs Pighills, Mr & Mrs Black, Mrs Leyland, Mr and Mrs Reynolds, Mrs Driscoll, Mr L. Hayton, Mr & Mrs Bayes and Mr and Mrs John Williams.

The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and approved.

Arising out of the Minutes the Chairman said that the County Council were unable to prove the litter bin; and the Telephone Manager had informed him that as the Exchange building was no longer Post Office property he was unable to do anything about its untidy state.

Mrs Williams requested the Chairman to find out how and when Parish Councillors following local government reform were to be elected and what the duties of these councillors would be.

Mr Williams and Mr Bayes requested the Chairman to approach the County Surveyor regarding potholes in the road, a pronounced "hump" at Low Bridge and the possibility of placing wire netting on the sides of the wooden footbridge near Rook Howe.

The meeting decided to continue to function until overlaid by local government reform and to continue in existence thereafter for the purpose of discussing Parish matters.
