The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held at the Institute pursuant to notice on the above date at 7.30 p.m.

Present at the Meeting were the Chairman, Professor and Mrs Reynolds, Mr & Mrs Bayes, Mr & Mrs Brownlow, Mrs Robinson and Mr Bialy.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

It was proposed by Mr Brownlow and seconded by Mr Bayes that the present Chairman should continue in office.

At this stage the Chairman indicated that he wished to resign at a suitable time in the fairly near future but that he would prefer that all parishioners were aware of this and were given an opportunity to nominate and vote for their candidate. The Meeting therefore decided that written notice should be given to all households in the parish inviting written nominations to reach the Chairman before the next half-yearly Meeting probably to be held early in November 1975, and that a list of nominees should be put on display at a suitable time before the November Meeting.

The Chairman undertook to enquire into the disappearance of the footpath sign at the corner of the road to Kentmere Hall, into the inadequacy of the weight restriction notice affecting the Kentmere road situated near Barley bridge; to enquire about the enforcement of the provisions of this notice and to request an inspection of the wooden bridge near Rook Howe with a view to having necessary repairs done.

A brief discussion of heating, maintenance and letting of the Institute building was held.
