*The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting was held at the Institute pursuant to notice on the above date at 7.30 p.m.*

*Present at the Meeting were the Chairman, Mrs Pighills, Mr Morton, Mrs Bialy, Mr & Mrs Dawson, Mr & Mrs John Williams, Mr & Mrs Black, Mr & Mrs Driscoll, Mr Frank Salkeld, Mr Carl Bayes, Mr Ivan Dickinson, Mr Eccles and Mr Dobson.*

*The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and approved. The Chairman stated that whilst written notice was supplied to each household in the Parish of the proposed election of a new Chairman, written nominations were not invited before the Meeting and no lists of nominees published. Proposals for a new Chairman were invited and the following were nominated:-*

*Mrs June Olive Williams, Mr John Williams, Mr Dennis Driscoll, Mr Ivan Dickinson, Mr Kenneth Dawson and Mr Frank Salkeld. The only nominee who indicated willingness to serve as Chairman was Mrs Willaims and she was elected unanimously.*

*A discussion of roads, bridges and footpaths followed and the new Chairman undertook to approach the proper authority about the repair of the footbridge, and about revision of the Rights of Way map and related sign markings.*

*At a meeting held in conjunction with the Institute Meeting on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> November 1976, Mrs Black thanked Mr Pighills for his work as Chairman over the years and said how much everyone appreciated his efforts. The chairman was asked to object to the Cumbria County Council regarding the downgrading of the Garburn and Longsleddale rights of way to bridleways. Proposed Mr Bayes, seconded Mrs Black, unanimously agreed, also to bring the attention of the Department of Highways to the following facts: water continuously on the Staveley/Kentmere road, Gravengate road & Hellwell Lane and potholes on Gravengate road.*

*Suggest a metal kissing type gate be erected at the wooden footbridge on footpath no.11*
