The annual assembly of the Parish Meeting was held in the Institute on Monday the 28th March 1977 at 7.30 p.m.

Those present were Mr & Mrs Black, Messrs I. Dickinson, S. Eccles, L. Hayton, R. Pighills, J.H. Williams & the Chairman.

1. *Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Proposed by Mr Pighills seconded Mr Black,*
2. *Matters Arising: The Chairman informed the meeting that work had been carried out by the County Council on the roads as requested & that a letter of objection to the downgrading of rights of way had been sent to the appropriate authority.*
3. *Road & Footpaths Mr Black said that the water was still flowing across the road at Gravengate & a manhole appeared to be wrongly positioned. It was felt that a new drain would be necessary.*
4. *Jubilee Celebrations: There was a lengthy discussion about the Jubilee Celebrations to possibly be held in June. It was agreed that any festivities should take place on the official holiday – June 7 but that a further meeting should be called at the Institute on April 6 to invite people from the valley to decide what was wanted & to delegate a committee to arrange things.
