- Work at the Pound is complete. There was discussion of a plaque for the gate. The bench was ready for installing and there was discussion of a rota for mowing the grass.
- Discussion of footpath adjacent to Cappelrigg driveway. The chairman said he would try to find the original maps which were used to compile the definitive map.
- Sadgill and Garburn roads are now classified P.U.R. (Priviledge Use Regulated) in the latest classification of Rights of Way. I Dickinson said erosion by motorcycles was becoming a problem over the Sadgill road. The management plan is currently voluntary – the LDNPA could take further action if this plan is not working.
- There was discussion of a community photograph and it was suggested that this could be taken at the Summer Celebrations in 2001
- Commemorative coins of the Queen Mother have been purchased and are to be distributed to the children at Christmas.
